10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-113.2 of Title 29, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission shall establish a
15 three-day and five-day special use permit to be purchased by a
16 landowner for a tract of land that is two hundred (200) acres or
17 more.

18 B. The special use permit shall allow residents and
19 nonresidents with the permission of the landowner to hunt and fish
20 on the tract of land, and the individuals shall be exempt from
21 hunting and fishing license requirements for the term that the
22 special use permit is issued.

23 C. The term for the special use permit shall only be for
24 consecutive days.

1 D. The price of the special use permit shall not exceed Five
2 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
