L 6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L7	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L 8	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-113.2 of Title 29, unless
L 9	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission shall establish a
21	three-day special use permit to be purchased by a landowner for a
22	tract of land that is two hundred (200) acres or more.
23	B. The special use permit shall allow any veterans and
24	nonprofit or charitable organizations, with the permission of the

1	landowner, to hunt and fish on the tract of land. Those veterans
2	and organizations permitted to hunt and fish on the tract of land
3	shall be exempt from hunting and fishing license requirements for
4	the term that the special use permit is issued.
5	C. The term for the special use permit shall only be for
6	consecutive days.
7	D. The price of the special use permit shall not exceed Five
8	Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
9	E. The Commission shall promulgate rules to enforce the
10	provisions of this act.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
