- 2. Except as otherwise provided by law, all state agencies that wish to request from the Legislature an increase in state funding shall be required to submit such request to the Legislature two (2) fiscal years in advance of the fiscal year in which the agency, board or commission wishes to receive such increase in funding.
- 3. Except as otherwise provided by law, the State Auditor and Inspector shall audit at least once every two (2) fiscal years the financial statements of all state agencies. The State Auditor and Inspector shall audit a state agency each fiscal year if that state agency is required to be audited on an annual basis pursuant to the federal Single Audit Act of 1984, as amended, 31 U.S.C., Section 7501 et seq.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
