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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1722, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1722. The purposes of the Oklahoma School for the Blind
17	shall be to:
18	1. Provide academic, vocational, social/emotional, and cultural
19	instruction as well as independent living skills and transitional
20	needs for children who are blind or visually impaired; and
21	2. Serve as a statewide resource center for educational
22	services for children who are blind or visually impaired; and
23	3. To evaluate and make individualized education program (IEP)
24	recommendations, in accordance with the Individuals with

Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), to school districts for blind and visually impaired students as identified by the State Department of <u>Education</u>.

4 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1734, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 Section 1734. The purposes of the Oklahoma School for the Deaf 7 shall be:

1. To provide academic, vocational, social/emotional, and 8 9 cultural instruction as well as independent living skills and transitional needs for children who are deaf or hard-of-hearing; and 10 11 2. To serve as a statewide resource center for educational 12 services for children who are deaf or hard-of-hearing; and 3. To evaluate and make individualized education program (IEP) 13 recommendations, in accordance with the Individuals with 14 Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), to school districts for deaf and 15 16 hearing impaired students as identified by the State Department of 17 Education.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
