12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 40.2 of Title 17, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	Any employee hired by the Corporation Commission on or after the
17	effective date of this act shall be in the unclassified service
18	unless the position is required to be subject to merit protections
19	as required by a federal program administered by the Oklahoma
20	Corporation Commission.
21	1. All future appointees to positions not required to be
22	subject to merit protections as required by a federal program
23	administered by the Commission shall be in the unclassified service.

1	2. In accordance with existing law, any classified employee who
2	is serving in a position on the effective date of the removal of the
3	position from classified service and placement into the unclassified
4	service shall have the option of retaining the employee's classified
5	status. If the employee chooses to remain in the classified
6	service, the position occupied by the employee shall remain in the
7	classified service until the employee either vacates the position or
8	elects unclassified status in writing. All future appointees to
9	such positions shall be in the unclassified service.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
