6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; allowing teachers to
8 accept donations for certain purpose; requiring
9 donations to be submitted with certain report;
10 requiring issuance of purchase order; requiring
11 issuance of certain receipt; providing for
12 codification; providing an effective date; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. A teacher employed by any public school district in this
19 state may accept donations from any person or corporation for the
20 purpose of providing classroom supplies or supporting classroom-
21 related activities.

22 B. A teacher who accepts donations pursuant to subsection A of
23 this section shall provide the donation to the school district's
24 financial officer with a report that includes the identity of the
donor, the amount donated and the purpose of the donation. The

1 school district's encumbrance clerk shall issue a purchase order
2 before any expenditure is made for classroom supplies or classroom-
3 related activities, pursuant to the provisions of Section 5-135 of
4 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The encumbrance clerk shall
5 provide to the donor a receipt for the amount received.

6 C. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to
7 implement the provisions of this section.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
