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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
17	A. There is hereby created the Task Force on the Electrical
18	Grid and Electromagnetic Pulse (EMP) Attacks to be composed of seven
19	members as follows:
20	1. Two members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro
21	Tempore of the Senate;
22	2. Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the
23	Speaker of the House of Representatives;
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3. Three members representing and knowledgeable of the electric
 utility industry, one each to be appointed by the President Pro
 Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives
 and the Governor.

B. Members of the task force shall be appointed no later than
July 1, 2016. The first meeting of the task force shall be at the
call of the Governor and at that meeting the appointed members shall
elect a chair. Activities of the task force shall terminate no
later than July 1, 2017.

10 C. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or 11 travel reimbursement.

12 D. The duty of the task force shall be to study the vulnerability of the state electrical grid system in the face of a 13 potential EMP attack, discuss preventive measures necessary to 14 protect the vital electrical grid system, and determine public and 15 private resources available to deliver assistance to utilities and 16 our citizens in the event of an EMP attack. The task force is 17 authorized to make any legislative recommendations as they determine 18 necessary and appropriate and shall report such recommendations to 19 the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the 20 Speaker of the House of Representatives. 21

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
