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7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to the Task Force on the Electrical
9 Grid and Electromagnetic Pulse Attacks; creating task
10 force; providing for appointments by certain date;
11 stating procedures; prohibiting compensation of
12 members; stating duties; authorizing task force to
13 make legislative recommendations; providing for
14 termination; providing for noncodification; and
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby created the Task Force on the Electrical
20 Grid and Electromagnetic Pulse (EMP) Attacks to be composed of seven
21 members as follows:

22 1. Two members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro
23 Tempore of the Senate;

24 2. Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the
Speaker of the House of Representatives;

1 3. Three members representing and knowledgeable of the electric
2 utility industry, one each to be appointed by the President Pro
3 Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives
4 and the Governor.

5 B. Members of the task force shall be appointed no later than
6 July 1, 2016. The first meeting of the task force shall be at the
7 call of the Governor and at that meeting the appointed members shall
8 elect a chair. Activities of the task force shall terminate no
9 later than July 1, 2017.

10 C. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or
11 travel reimbursement.

12 D. The duty of the task force shall be to study the
13 vulnerability of the state electrical grid system in the face of a
14 potential EMP attack, discuss preventive measures necessary to
15 protect the vital electrical grid system, and determine public and
16 private resources available to deliver assistance to utilities and
17 our citizens in the event of an EMP attack. The task force is
18 authorized to make any legislative recommendations as they determine
19 necessary and appropriate and shall report such recommendations to
20 the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
21 Speaker of the House of Representatives.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
