15	A. It shall be a felony for any member of the Communist Party
16	of China (CPC) or any person who has ever held employment as an
17	official or authority within the government of the People's Republic
18	of China (PRC) to own any property within this state.
19	B. It shall be a felony for any member of the Communist Party
20	of China (CPC) or any person who has ever held employment as an
21	official or authority within the government of the People's Republic
22	of China (PRC) to harass, intimidate, or threaten any citizen of
23	this state.

Any member of the Communist Party of China (CPC) or any 2 person who has ever held employment as an official or authority 3 within the government of the People's Republic of China (PRC) shall 4 register with the Governor, Secretary of State, President Pro 5 Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and 6 all members of the congressional delegation of this state before 7 entering this state in writing. 8 D. The provisions of subsections A, B, and C or this act shall 9 apply to any person who has ever held employment as an official or 10 authority within the government of any country currently categorized 11 as being a dictatorship or as being communist according to the 12 United States State Department or the United States Central 13 Intelligence Agency. 14 SECTION 2.
