An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 2011, Section 40.7, which relates to admissibility of expert testimony; clarifying admissibility of certain testimony; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Admissibility of expert testimony

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 40.7, is amended to read as follows:

Section 40.7. In an action in a court of this state, if a party offers evidence of domestic abuse, testimony of an expert witness concerning including, but not limited to, the effects of such domestic abuse on the beliefs, behavior and perception of the person being abused shall be admissible as evidence.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
