12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2011, Section 1005.1, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 1005.1. A. As used in this section:
15	1. "Administrative sanction" means the court may enter an order
16	making an individual who violates a provision of this section
17	ineligible for assistance for a specified period of time. Such
18	order shall be communicated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority
19	Legal Division; and
20	2. "Insure Oklahoma" means the program administered by the
21	Oklahoma Health Care Authority pursuant to Sections 1010.1 through
22	1010.13 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

Obtains or attempts to obtain, or aids, abets or assists any 2 individual to obtain, by means of a false statement or 3 representation, or by false impersonation, or by a fictitious transfer, conveyance or encumbrance of property or income, or by a 4 5 knowing and willful failure to report to the Department of Human Services or the Oklahoma Health Care Authority income, personal 6 7 property, real property, household members, or other material eligibility factors at the time of application or during the receipt 8 9 of assistance, or by other fraudulent device, assistance to which an 10 applicant is not entitled or assistance greater than that to which 11 an applicant is justly entitled shall be guilty of a misdemeanor or 12 a felony;

13 2. By sale, barter, purchase, theft, acquisition, possession or
14 use of any medical identification card or any other device
15 authorizing participation in the Oklahoma Medicaid Program,
16 knowingly obtains, aids, abets or assists any individual to obtain
17 or attempt to obtain assistance to which an individual is not
18 entitled shall be guilty of a misdemeanor or a felony; or

3. Attempts to obtain Medicaid or Insure Oklahoma benefits by omitting income, personal property, household members, or other material eligibility factors shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by either a fine of three times the amount of assistance, or up to three (3) months in the county jail. In addition, the individual may also be punished by an administrative

sanction regarding Medicaid benefits. The court shall have
 discretion in determining penalties.

If the acts in either paragraph 1 or 2 of subsection B of this section or both paragraphs 1 and 2 of subsection B of this 4 5 section cause the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to determine that an individual or family is eligible for Medicaid or the Insure 6 7 Oklahoma program and the aggregate amount of assistance paid on behalf of the individual or individuals is less than Five Thousand 8 9 Dollars (\$5,000.00), the penalty, upon conviction, shall be a 10 misdemeanor punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both a fine and 11 imprisonment for three (3) months or an administrative sanction regarding Medicaid benefits in the discretion of the court. If the 12 13 acts in paragraph 1 or 2 of subsection B of this section or both paragraphs 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section cause the 14 15 Oklahoma Health Care Authority to determine an individual or family eligible for Medicaid or the Insure Oklahoma program and the 16 17 aggregate amount of assistance paid on behalf of the individual or individuals is equal to or greater than Five Thousand Dollars 18 (\$5,000.00), the penalty, upon conviction, shall be a felony 19 punishable by fine or imprisonment or both a fine and imprisonment 20 for not more than five (5) years or an administrative sanction 21 regarding Medicaid benefits in the discretion of the court. 22 23 D. Each application for Medicaid assistance shall contain a
