6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Council on Judicial  
8 Complaints; authorizing provision of funding for  
9 certain purpose; establishing certain contracting  
10 authority; authorizing provision of certain programs;  
11 providing for codification; providing an effective  
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1651.1 of Title 20, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Council on Judicial Complaints is authorized to provide  
18 funding for the attendance and participation of state, municipal,  
19 and administrative judges in professional and educational programs,  
20 schools or conferences for the purpose of improving the quality of  
21 the Oklahoma Judiciary and to improve the administration of justice  
22 in this state. The Council may contract or partner with public or  
23 private entities or otherwise fund and participate in the  
24 development, implementation, and conduct of professional and  
educational programs for judges.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
