8	Inspection Act; amending 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-625, which relates to exemptions;
9	providing requirements for exemptions; and providing an effective date.
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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-265, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 6-265. A. The <u>State</u> Board <u>of Agriculture</u> shall, by
16	regulation and under such conditions, including requirements, as to
17	sanitary standards, practices, and procedures as it may prescribe,
18	exempt from specific provisions of this act with respect to
19	processing of poultry or poultry products solely for intrastate
20	commerce and distribution of poultry or poultry products only in
21	such commerce:
22	1. for such period of time as the Board determines that it
23	would be impracticable to provide inspection and the exemption will
24 2 -	aid in the effective administration of this act, any person engaged

¹ in the processing of poultry or poultry products and the poultry or ² poultry products processed by such person; provided, that, no such ³ exemption shall continue in effect more than one hundred twenty ⁴ (120) days after enactment of this act;

5 2. persons slaughtering, processing, or otherwise handling 6 poultry or poultry products which have been or are to be processed 7 as required by recognized religious dietary laws, to the extent that 8 the Board determines necessary to avoid conflict with such 9 requirements while still effectuating the purposes of this act;

10 the slaughtering by any person of poultry of his or her 3. 11 own raising, and the processing by him or her and transportation of 12 the poultry products exclusively for use by him and members of his 13 or her household and his or her nonpaying guests and employees; 14 provided that such poultry products when so distributed, bear, in 15 lieu of labeling that would otherwise be required, the producer's 16 name and address and the statement "Exempted - P.L. 90-492" and such 17 poultry products are not otherwise misbranded;

4. the custom slaughter by any person of poultry delivered by the owner thereof for such slaughter, and the processing by such slaughterer and transportation of the poultry products exclusively for use, in the household of such owner, by him <u>or her</u> and members of his <u>or her</u> household and his <u>or her</u> nonpaying guests and employees; provided, that;

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1	<u>a.</u>	such custom slaughterer does not engage in the
2		business of buying or selling any poultry products
3		capable of use as human food, and

4	<u>b.</u>	such poultry products when so distributed, bear, in
5		lieu of labeling that would otherwise be required, the
6		producer's name and address and the statement
7		"Exempted - P.L. 90-492" and such poultry products are
8		not otherwise misbranded;

9 5. operations of types traditionally and usually conducted 10 at retail stores and restaurants, when conducted at any retail store 11 or restaurant or similar retail-type establishment for sale in 12 normal retail quantities or service of such articles to consumers at 13 such establishments, if no poultry or poultry products are processed 14 at the establishment for distribution within this state or otherwise 15 subject to inspection under the Federal Poultry Products Inspection 16 Act.

⊥ /	6. the slaughtering of sound and healthy poultry and
18	processing of poultry products therefrom in this state by any
19	poultry producer on the producer's own premises with respect to
20	poultry raised on the producer's premises, and the distribution by
21	any person solely within this state of the poultry products derived
22	from such operations; provided that:
23	a. in lieu of complying with all the adulteration

19	processing of	poultry products of such poultry in this state by any
20	poultry produ	cer or other person for distribution by them solely
21	within this s	tate directly to household consumers, restaurants,
22	hotels and bo	ardinghouses for use in their own dining rooms, or in
23	the preparati	on of meals for sales direct to consumers; provided
24 2 -	that:	

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1	<u>a.</u>	in lieu of complying with all the adulteration
2		provisions of this act, such poultry is slaughtered
3		and otherwise processed and handled under such
4		sanitary standards, practices and procedures as result
5		in the preparation of poultry products that are sound,
6		clean and fit for human food when distributed by such
7		processor,
8	<u>b.</u>	such poultry products when so distributed bear, in
9		lieu of labeling that would otherwise be required, the
10		processor's name and address and the statement
11		"Exempted - P.L. 90-492" and such poultry products are
12		not otherwise misbranded,
13	<u>C.</u>	such processor does not engage in the current calendar
14		year in the business of buying or selling any poultry
15		or poultry products other than as specified in
16		paragraphs 6 and 7 of this subsection, and
17	<u>d.</u>	such processor does not exceed the volume limitation
18		prescribed in subsection B of this section.
19	8.	the operations and products of small enterprises
20	including pou	ltry producers, not exempted under paragraphs 1 through
21	7 of this sub	section that are engaged in this state in slaughtering
22	or cutting up	poultry for distribution as carcasses or parts thereof
23	solely for di	stribution within this state; provided that:
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1	<u>a.</u>	such poultry is sound and healthy when slaughtered and
2		is slaughtered or cut up and handled under such
3		sanitary standards, practices and procedures as result
4		in the preparation of poultry products that are not
5		adulterated when so distributed, and
6	b.	when so distributed, such poultry products are not
7		misbranded, except that the official inspection legend
8		shall not be used.
9	B. <u>No pe</u>	rson qualifies for any exemption specified in
10	paragraphs 6,	7 and 8 of subsection A if, in the current calendar
11	year, such pe	rson:
12	<u>1.</u>	slaughters or processes the products of more than
13	twenty thousa	nd (20,000) poultry; or
14	2.	slaughters or processes poultry products at a facility
15	used for slau	ghtering or processing poultry products by any other
16	person, excep	t when the Departmentof Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
17	grants such e	xemption after determining, upon review of a person's
18	application,	that such an exemption will not impair effectuating the
19	purposes of t	his act.
20	<u>C.</u> The p	rovisions of this act shall not apply to poultry
21	producers wit	h respect to poultry of their own raising on their own
22	farms if <u>:</u>	
23	1.	such producers slaughter not more than two hundred
24 2 -	fifty turkeys	, or not more than an equivalent number of birds of all

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1 species during the calendar year for which this exemption is being 2 determined, four birds of other species being deemed the equivalent 3 of one turkey;

4 2. such poultry producers do not engage in buying or
5 selling poultry products other than those produced from poultry
6 raised on their own farms.

⁷ C. D. The adulteration and misbranding provisions of this act,
 ⁸ other than the requirement of the inspection legend, shall apply to
 ⁹ articles which are exempted from inspection under this section.

¹⁰ $\overrightarrow{\text{D. E.}}$ The Board may by order suspend or terminate any exemption ¹¹ with respect to any person whenever it finds that such action will ¹² aid in effectuating the purposes of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
