13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-122, as
14	last amended by Section 5, Chapter 266, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
15	2015, Section 6-122), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 6-122. The Department of Public Safety may develop
17	procedures whereby driver licenses issued under the provisions of
18	Section 6-101 et seq. of this title may be renewed or replaced by
19	the applicant by mail or online except for licenses to be renewed <u>or</u>
20	replaced by aliens as prescribed by subsection E of Section 6-115 of
21	this title. Any license issued pursuant to this section shall be
22	valid for a period as prescribed in Section 6-115 of this title.
23	The Department shall not renew <u>or replace</u> a license by mail or

1	online unless the immediately preceding issuance or <u>,</u> renewal <u>or</u>
2	replacement was done in person by the applicant.
3	Provided, any person or the spouse or dependent of a person:
4	1. Who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United
5	States; or
6	2. Who is currently employed as a civilian contractor with the
7	Armed Forces of the United States, living outside of Oklahoma and
8	having a valid class D driver license issued by the State of
9	Oklahoma, requiring no material change, may apply for no more than
10	three consecutive renewals or replacements of such license by mail
11	or online, in accordance with Department rules. A fourth
12	consecutive renewal or replacement must be done in person.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
