7	An Act relating to income tax credit; providing
8	credit for members of the Oklahoma National Guard that purchase a home; providing amount of credit;

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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2357.70 of Title 68, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. For tax year 2024 and subsequent tax years, there shall be
19	allowed against the tax imposed by Section 2355 of Title 68 of the
20	Oklahoma Statutes a credit for individuals that are members of the
21	Oklahoma Army National Guard or Oklahoma Air National Guard who
22	purchase a residence in this state.
23	B. The credit authorized shall be equal to the down payment and
24 27	closing costs associated with the purchase but in no event shall

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1	exceed Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00). The Oklahoma Tax
2	Commission shall provide a form for individuals to apply for the
3	credit and submit verification of down payment and payment of
4	closing costs.
5	C. The credit provided by this section shall be refundable. No
6	more than one credit provided by this section shall be claimed by an
7	individual.
8	D. The Oklahoma Tax Commission may promulgate rules to
9	effectuate the provisions of this act.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
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
