6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Concurrent Resolution encouraging high schools to
8 partner with technology center schools to offer
9 Junior Officers' Training Corps programs; recognizing
10 the values instilled by the Junior Officers' Training
11 Corps; marking the involvement in Junior Officers'
12 Training Corps programs in Oklahoma; and directing
13 distribution.

14 WHEREAS, the Junior Officers' Training Corps instills in high
15 school students the values of citizenship, service to the United
16 States and personal responsibility; and

17 WHEREAS, the focus of Army JROTC is reflected in its mission,
18 "To motivate young people to be better citizens"; and

19 WHEREAS, there are eighteen (18) Army JROTC programs in Oklahoma
20 with a total enrollment of two thousand five hundred and three
21 (2,503).

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
23 OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
24 CONCURRING THEREIN:

1 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby encourages Oklahoma
2 high schools to partner with technology center schools to offer
3 Junior Officers' Training Corps programs to bring its focus on
4 citizenship to more high school students in the state.

5 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the State Board
6 of Education and the State Board of Career and Technology Education
7 to be shared with high schools and technology center schools across
8 the state.
