17 Tigers, the 2017 Class 4A State Wrestling Champions;  
18 commending Head Coach Matt Surber for his leadership  
and dedication; and directing distribution.

20 WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers wrestling team won their eighth  
21 consecutive Class 4A Dual State Championship and the school's 14th  
22 overall on February 20, 2017, at Oklahoma State Fair Arena; and

1       WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers also won the 2017 Class 4A State  
2 Championship, the school's ninth overall, with 197.5 points; and

3       WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers are ranked 11th in the country; and

4       WHEREAS, the Tuttle wrestling team was also named the 2017  
5 Academic State Champions with an overall G.P.A. of 3.70; and

6       WHEREAS, the team had seven Individual State Champions including  
7 Cale Johnson, Carson Berryhill, Luke Surber, Brik Filippo, Tanner  
8 Johnson, Rhett Golowenski and Tanner Litterell; and

9       WHEREAS, the team had two State Runner-ups, Brady DeArmond and  
10 Dustin Plott as well as Ryder Ramsey who placed third and Gunner  
11 Meyer who got fourth place; and

12       WHEREAS, the victory was senior Tanner Litterell's fourth state  
13 championship making him the second Tuttle Tiger since 2013 graduate,  
14 Zachary Beard, to win four individual state titles; and

15       WHEREAS, seniors Tanner Litterell and Brik Filippo finished  
16 their season undefeated, making them the first two Tuttle wrestlers  
17 in Coach Matt Surber's tenure to finish the same season undefeated;  
18 and

19       WHEREAS, during his eleven years as head coach, Matt Surber has  
20 created a legacy of excellence and champions at Tuttle High School.

21       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
22 OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
23 CONCURRING THEREIN:

1        THAT the Legislature congratulates the Tuttle Tigers on winning  
2 the 2017 Class 4A State Wrestling Championship, the Dual State  
3 Championship and the Academic State Championship.

4        THAT the Legislature commends Head Coach Matt Surber for his  
5 eleven years of leadership and dedication to the Tuttle wrestling  
6 program.
