WHEREAS, approximately 2,000 people will be settled in Oklahoma without the citizens of this state or their elected officials being involved in the settlement process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature of the State of Oklahoma, as duly elected representatives of our constituents and the State, hereby call on the members of our federal delegation in Congress to introduce legislation amending the Refugee Act of 1980 to include a provision that refugees may only be settled in any state of the Union with approval of the duly elected officials of that state, leaving it to each state to determine the methods of such approval requirements for future refugees whether by granting authority to the executive branch of state government, or retaining authority within the legislative branch of state government.

Congressional Delegation, the President of the Senate of the United

States, the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United

States, and the President and Vice President of the United States.
