15	utilized to discriminate, shun, and shame those who do not walk in

17	WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma is made up of parents and
18	grandparents, and those who respect both, who believe that each
19	child and college student is equal and should have the same
20	opportunities under our U.S. Constitution; and
21	WHEREAS, we believe DEI is unconstitutional in its disparate
22	treatment of students and faculty and goes directly against the
23	equality guaranteed in the Bill of Rights and the 14th Amendment;
