WHEREAS, Biblical teachings inspired concepts of civil government that are contained in our Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States; and

WHEREAS, many of our great national leaders, among them

Presidents Washington, Jackson, Lincoln, and Wilson, have paid

tribute to the surpassing influence of the Bible in our country's

development, and in the words of President Jackson, the Bible is

"the rock on which our Republic rests"; and

WHEREAS, the history of our nation clearly illustrates the value of voluntarily applying the teachings of the Holy Scriptures in the lives of individuals, families, and societies; and

WHEREAS, this state and nation now face great challenges that will test us as we have never been tested before; and

WHEREAS, renewing our knowledge of and faith in God through the Holy Scriptures can strengthen us as a state, a nation, and a people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby authorizes and requests the Governor, Executive branch, and all subdivisions of this state to designate 2024 as the Year of the Bible in the State of Oklahoma in recognition of the formative influence the Bible has been for our
