NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature requests that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority cancel the Request for Proposals for care coordination models for the aged, blind and disabled populations issued on November 30, 2016.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature requests that the Oklahoma
Health Care Authority work with the Centers for Medicare and
Medicaid Services to resolve any questions about the long-term
viability of supplemental payments and/or pass-through payments for
health care providers including, but not limited to, hospitals,
nursing homes, physicians and medical schools, under a care
coordination model.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature requests that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority work with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to ensure the rates for care coordination are actuarially sound.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature requests that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority reissue a Request for Proposals by May 1, 2017, for care coordination models for aged, blind and disabled persons.
