19 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Veterans Pilot Program has been created to  
20 develop a 21st Century healthcare delivery system for the Oklahoma  
21 veterans' community; and

22 WHEREAS, the healthcare delivery system will be part of a  
23 private/public partnership designed to improve timely access to  
24 services, the quality of care provided, improve efficiency and

1 create a cost savings to participating federal and state agencies;

3 WHEREAS, the healthcare services will be designed as one  
4 seamless transitional system of care across Oklahoma; and

5 WHEREAS, the transitional system of care developed will be  
6 tested and placed into action with appropriate monitoring and  
7 outcome measures recorded; and

8 WHEREAS, the final healthcare product may be considered as a  
9 national model after the testing and action period; and

10 WHEREAS, this initiative is being supported by professionals in  
11 healthcare, the business and finance community, higher education  
12 professionals, community leaders and veterans from around the great  
13 state of Oklahoma.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
15 OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
16 CONCURRING THEREIN:

18 Veterans Pilot Program.

19 THAT the Legislature encourages all Oklahomans to participate
