The Legislature shall also meet in regular session at the seat 1 of government on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January 2 of each odd numbered year, beginning at twelve o'clock noon for the 3 purposes only of performing the duties as required by Section 5 of Article VI of the Constitution and organizing pursuant to the 5 provisions of this Article and shall recess not later than five 6 o'clock p.m. of that same day until the following first Monday in February of the same year, beginning at twelve o'clock noon. 8 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 9 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this act shall be in the 10 following form: 11
