 - B. The Legislature shall be authorized to enact such laws as may be necessary in order to implement this provision. For the purposes of this provision, the term "public safety services" shall include the purchase, operation and maintenance of equipment, the payment of salaries and benefits of employees who provide law enforcement and/or fire protection services and costs assessed for housing prisoners of the city or town.
 - SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure creates a new Section 10C of Article 10 of the Oklahoma Constitution. It allows voters of certain cities or towns to approve an increase in property taxes. The increase is limited to 10 mills on the dollar value of property. The additional tax would be used for public safety services. The Legislature could enact laws needed to implement this provision. It also defines public safety services.
