19	Section 3. The <u>A minimum of seventy percent (70%) of all</u>
20	revenue, as stated in the comprehensive annual financial report for
21	the corresponding year for the permanent school fund, regardless of
22	source, shall be placed in the average daily attendance formula
23	including but not limited to interest and income of the permanent
24 23	school fund, the net income from the leasing of public lands which

1 have been or may be granted by the United States to the State for 2 the use and benefit of the common schools, together with any 3 revenues derived from taxes authorized to be levied for such 4 purposes, and any other sums which may be added thereto by law, 5 shall be used and applied each year for the benefit of the common 6 schools of the State, and shall be, for this purpose, apportioned 7 among and between all the several common school districts of the 8 State in proportion to the school population of the several 9 districts, and no part of the fund shall ever be diverted from this 10 purpose, or used for any other purpose than the support and 11 maintenance of common schools for the equal benefit of all the 12 people of the State. 13 SECTION 1.
