B. Nothing in this section shall preclude the appropriation, application, donation or use, directly or indirectly, of public money or property for the use, benefit or support of a monument, memorial, plaque or other commemorative signage inscribed with the Ten Commandments on a public building or grounds of a public building in this state, provided that:

- 1. The height, width and depth of the monument is proportionate to other monuments on the public building or grounds of the public building;
- 2. The height, width and depth of the memorial, plaque or other commemorative signage is proportionate to other memorials, plaques or commemorative signage on the public building or grounds of the public building;
- 3. The primary content inscribed on the monument, memorial,

 plaque or other commemorative signage is the text of the Ten

 Commandments; and
- 4. Any remaining content inscribed on the monument, memorial,

 plaque or other commemorative signage is limited to an

 acknowledgment of the historical role of the Ten Commandments in the

 legal and political history of the United States of America and the

 State of Oklahoma, and the person, persons or organizations

 responsible for donating, building, erecting or maintaining the

 monument, memorial, plaque or other commemorative signage.
