6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
8 to refer to the people for their approval or  
9 rejection the question of calling a Constitutional  
10 Convention which shall be authorized to propose  
11 alterations, revisions or amendments to the Oklahoma  
12 Constitution or to propose a new Constitution;  
13 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
15 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

16 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
18 the question, pursuant specifically to Section 2 of Article XXIV of  
19 the Oklahoma Constitution, of calling a Constitutional Convention  
20 which shall be authorized to propose alterations, revisions or  
21 amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution or to propose a new  
22 Constitution for the State of Oklahoma.

23 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
24 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

Shall the Legislature call a Constitutional Convention which shall be authorized to propose alterations, revisions or amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution or to propose a new Constitution for the State of Oklahoma?

SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall, immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.
