A. The fundamental right of a each individual 19 citizen to keep and to bear arms in defense of his home, person, or 20 property, or including handguns, rifles, shotguns, knives, nonlethal 21 defensive weapons and other arms in common use, as well as 22 ammunition and the components of arms and ammunition, for self-23 defense, lawful hunting and recreation, in aid of the civil power,

3	B. This section shall not prevent the Legislature from

7	serve a compelling state interest.
8	C. No law shall impose registration or special taxation upon
