15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
16	2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
17	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19	the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the
20	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:
21	Section 1. Qualifications of electors.
22	Subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may prescribe, all
23	only citizens of the United States $_{ au}$ who are over the age of eighteen

1	(18) years $_{m{ au}}$ and who are bona fide residents of this state $_{m{ au}}$ are
2	qualified electors of this state.
3	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
4	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
5	the following form:
6	BALLOT TITLE
7	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
8	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
9	This measure amends Section 1 of Article 3 of the Oklahoma
10	Constitution. It clarifies that only citizens of the United
11	States are qualified to vote in this state.
12	SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
13	FOR THE PROPOSAL - YES
14	AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO
15	SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
16	immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
17	one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2
18	hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney
19	General.
