No A. Except as provided for in subsection B of 21 this section, no member of the Legislature shall, during the term 22 for which he or she was elected, be appointed or elected to any

office or commission in the State, which shall have been created, or

the emoluments of which shall have been increased, during his or her

2	the Governor, the Governor and Senate, or from the Legislature,

4	shall any member, during the term for which he or she shall have
5	been elected, or within two years thereafter, be interested,
6	directly or indirectly, in any contract with the State, or any
7	county or other subdivision thereof, authorized by law passed during
8	the term for which he <u>or she</u> shall have been elected.
9	B. The provisions of this section shall not operate to prohibit
10	a member of the Legislature from being employed as a certified
11	teacher by a public school district in this state after completing
12	the term to which he or she was elected.
