13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
14	1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
18	adding a new Section 24A to Article II to read as follows:
19	Section 24A. No private personal property seized by law
20	enforcement shall be forfeited unless the owner of the property is
21	convicted of an offense requiring such forfeiture, as determined by
22	the Legislature.

1	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
2	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
3	the following form:
4	BALLOT TITLE
5	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
6	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
7	This measure adds a new section to the Oklahoma Constitution.
8	It adds Section 24A to Article 2. It prohibits personal
9	property from being forfeited unless the owner is convicted of
10	an offense.
11	SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
12	FOR THE PROPOSAL - YES
13	AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO
14	SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
15	immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
16	one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2
17	hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney
18	General.
