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6	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
7	rejection a proposed amendment to Article I of the Oklahoma Constitution, by adding a new section;
8	requiring persons appearing to vote to announce name and provide proof of identity; defining term;
9	providing exception; granting certain authority to
10	Legislature; providing ballot title; directing filing; and ordering a special election.
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13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
14	1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
18	adding a new Section 8 to Article I to read as follows:
19	Section 8. A. Each person appearing to vote shall provide
20	proof of identity, whereupon the appropriate election official shall
21	verify the person's eligibility to vote, as provided by law.
22	B. The Legislature shall have the authority to enact such laws
23	as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

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1	SECTION 2. A special election is hereby ordered to be held
2	throughout the State of Oklahoma on the date of the next statewide
3	primary election or special election, whichever occurs first, at
4	which time the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State
5	of Oklahoma, as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution, shall be
6	submitted to the people of Oklahoma for their approval or rejection
7	as and in the manner provided by law.
8	SECTION 3. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
9	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
10	the following form:

12	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
13	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
14	This measure would enact a new Section 8 in Article 1 of the
15	Oklahoma Constitution. It would require each person appearing
16	to vote to provide proof of identity. The appropriate election
17	official would verify the person's eligibility to vote. The
18	Legislature would enact laws to implement the provisions of the
19	new section.
