14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
19	adding a new Section 2A to Article II to read as follows:
20	Section 2A. Recognizing that abortion is a unique and
21	destructive act that terminates the life of an unborn human being,
22	nothing in this Constitution secures or protects a right to an
23	abortion.

1	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
2	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
3	the following form:

5	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
6	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
7	This measure adds a new Section 2A to Article 2 of the Oklahoma
8	Constitution. The proposed Section 2A recognizes that abortion
9	is a unique and destructive act that ends the life of an unborn
10	human being. The proposed Section 2A states that nothing in the
11	Oklahoma Constitution secures or protects a right to an
12	abortion.
13	SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
14	FOR THE PROPOSAL — YES
15	AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO
16	SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
17	immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
18	one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2
19	hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney
20	General.
