6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
8 to refer to the people for their approval or
9 rejection a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma
10 Constitution by adding a new Section 38 to Article
11 II; prohibiting the use of any system using
12 behavioral attributes to deny individual rights;
13 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

16 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18 the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
19 adding a new Section 38 to Article II to read as follows:

20 Section 38. The right of the people to be free from being
21 burdened by the use of a social credit score shall not be violated.
22 It shall be unlawful for the Legislature, the Governor, or the
23 courts within the jurisdiction of this state to create any system
24 using behavioral attributes of an individual as cause to deny the
individual their rights. Algorithms based in whole or in part using

1 predictive analytics and/or artificial intelligence shall not be
2 used to prevent a person from exercising their rights.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
5 the following form:

7 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure would create a new Section 38 of Article 2 of the
10 Oklahoma Constitution. The measure would prohibit the State of
11 Oklahoma, the Governor of Oklahoma and the courts having
12 jurisdiction within this state from creating any system using
13 behavioral attributes of an individual as cause to deny their
14 rights.
