15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
18	adding a new Section 38 to Article II to read as follows:
19	Section 38. The right of the people to be free from being
20	burdened by the use of a social credit score shall not be violated.
21	It shall be unlawful for the Legislature, the Governor, or the
22	courts within the jurisdiction of this state to create any system
23	using behavioral attributes of an individual as cause to deny the

9	This measure would create a new Section 38 of Article 2 of the
10	Oklahoma Constitution. The measure would prohibit the State of
11	Oklahoma, the Governor of Oklahoma and the courts having
12	jurisdiction within this state from creating any system using
13	behavioral attributes of an individual as cause to deny their
14	rights.
