6	AS INTRODUCED
7	A Joint Resolution making two separate applications
8	to the United States Congress to call a convention of the states under Article V of the United States
9	Constitution for the purpose of proposing amendments to the United States Constitution related to
10	balancing the federal budget, imposing fiscal restraints on the federal government, limiting the
11	power and jurisdiction of the federal government and limiting the terms of office for its officials and
12	for members of Congress; providing for construction of applications; directing transmission; and
13	specifying that applications constitute continuing application.

15	
16	WHEREAS, the founders of the Constitution of the United States,
17	through the enactment of Article V, empowered state legislators to
18	be guardians of liberty against future abuses of power by the
19	federal government; and
20	WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing national
21	debt through improper and imprudent spending; and
22	WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate roles
23	of the states through the manipulative process of federal mandates,
24 27	most of which are unfunded to a great extent; and

WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to live under a proper interpretation of the Constitution of the United States; and

WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the Hiberty of our people, particularly for the generations to come, by proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States through a convention of the states under Article V of the United States Constitution to place clear restraints on these and related abuses of power; and

9 WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Oklahoma believe that it 10 is in the best interest of the people of the United States to amend 11 the United States Constitution in order to adopt a balanced budget 12 amendment and to address the areas of overreach of the federal 13 government; and

WHEREAS, as early as 1976, the Thirty-fifth Oklahoma Legislature enacted House Joint Resolution No. 1049, calling for an Article V Convention for the purpose of preparing and submitting to the states an amendment "requiring in the absence of a national emergency that the total of all federal appropriations made by the Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenue for that fiscal year"; and

WHEREAS, the Thirty-fifth Oklahoma Legislature acknowledged in House Joint Resolution No. 1049 the critical need for a federal balanced budget amendment with the prophetic statement "believing that fiscal irresponsibility at the federal level, with the

¹ inflation which results from this policy, is the greatest threat ² which faces our nation, we firmly believe that constitutional ³ restraint is necessary to bring the fiscal discipline needed to ⁴ restore fiscal responsibility"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article V of the
Constitution of the United States, each state may request Congress
to provide for a convention to propose amendments.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF 9 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 10 The Oklahoma Legislature hereby makes two separate SECTION 1. 11 applications to Congress, under the provisions of Article V of the 12 Constitution of the United States. The first such application is 13 set forth in Sections 2 through 5 of this resolution. The second 14 such application is set forth in Sections 6 through 9 of this 15 resolution.

16 SECTION 2. The Oklahoma Legislature hereby applies to Congress, 17 under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United 18 States, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to 19 proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States 20 requiring that in the absence of a national emergency the total of 21 all federal appropriations made by the Congress for any fiscal year 22 may not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for that 23 fiscal year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal 24 restraints. _ _

SECTION 3. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives and members of the United States Senate and House of Representatives from this state; also to transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of the legislative houses in several states, requesting their cooperation.

8 SECTION 4. This application is to be considered as covering the 9 same subject matter as the presently outstanding balanced budget 10 applications from other states including, but not limited to, 11 previously adopted applications from Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, 12 Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, 13 Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, 14 Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, 15 Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah and West 16 Virginia; and this application shall be aggregated with same for the 17 purpose of attaining the two-thirds (2/3) of states necessary to 18 require the calling of a convention, but shall not be aggregated 19 with any applications on any other subject.

SECTION 5. This application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the several states have made applications on the same subject. It

3 SECTION 6. The Legislature of the State of Oklahoma hereby 4 applies to Congress, under the provisions of Article V of the 5 Constitution of the United States, for the calling of a convention 6 of the states limited to proposing amendments to the United States 7 Constitution that impose fiscal restraints on the federal 8 government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal 9 government, and limit the terms of office for its officials and for 10 members of Congress.

SECTION 7. This application shall be aggregated with the applications of the various states and together with any future applications for a convention for the specific and exclusive purpose of proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States limited to the purposes stated herein.

16 SECTION 8. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to 17 transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary 18 of the United States Senate and to the Speaker and Clerk of the 19 United States House of Representatives, to transmit copies to the 20 members of the United States Senate and United States House of 21 Representatives from this state, and to transmit copies hereof to 22 the presiding officers of each of the legislative houses in the 23 several states, requesting their cooperation.

1	SECTION 9. This application constitutes a continuing
2	application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the
3	United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds $(2/3)$ of
4	the several states have made applications on the same subject, or
5	until December 31, 2028, whichever occurs earlier.
