12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
13	1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
14	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
15	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
16	the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article XXIV of the
17	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:
18	Section 1. Any amendment or amendments to this Constitution may
19	be proposed in either branch of the Legislature, and if the same
20	shall be agreed to by a majority of all the members elected to each
21	of the two (2) houses, such proposed amendment or amendments shall,
22	with the yeas and nays thereon, be entered in their journals and
23	referred by the Secretary of State to the people for their approval
24 27	or rejection, at the next regular general election, except when the

Legislature, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of each house, shall order a special election for that purpose. If <u>a majority not less than</u> <u>sixty percent (60%)</u> of all the electors voting on any proposed amendment at such election shall vote in favor thereof, it shall thereby become a part of this Constitution.

No proposal for the amendment or alteration of this Constitution which is submitted to the voters shall embrace more than one general subject and the voters shall vote separately for or against each proposal submitted; provided, however, that in the submission of proposals for the amendment of this Constitution by articles, which embrace one general subject, each proposed article shall be deemed a single proposal or proposition.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:
