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12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
13	THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
16	The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall cease all activities,
17	contracts, promulgated rules and similar functions relating to the
18	implementation of care coordination models for aged, blind and
19	disabled persons as provided by House Bill 1566 of the 1st Session
20	of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature. No activities, contracts or rules
21	promulgated by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board pursuant to
22	House Bill 1566 of the 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature,
23	including but not limited to rules or activities relating to

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1	requests for proposals or requests for quotes, shall be effective
2	without the affirmative approval of the Legislature.
3	SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
4	distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor and the
5	Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
9	effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
