14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
19	adding a new Section 10 to Article XIII to read as follows:
20	Section 10. A. 1. Upon the School Modernization and Renew
21	Teaching Commission submitting the proposed legislation to the
22	Legislature, as required by Section 9 of Article XIII of the
23	Oklahoma Constitution, the Office of the State Treasurer shall

- certify the estimated amount of operational and ongoing cost savings that would be created by the proposed legislation.
 - 2. If the proposed legislation is signed by the Governor or is approved by failure of the Governor to take any action, the estimated amount of savings shall be placed in a special account to be available for state appropriation for the purpose of increasing the minimum compensation for teachers in public school districts.
 - B. The Legislature is authorized to enact laws necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- 10 C. The provisions of this section shall expire on December 31, 11 2021.

 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
 the following form:
