## 1 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 2 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th Legislature (2017) 3 SENATE RESOLUTION 1x By: Schulz, Sparks, Treat, Stanislawski, Thompson, 4 Simpson, Jech, Pemberton, 5 Paxton, Pederson, Griffin, Shaw and Pittman 6 7 8 AS INTRODUCED 9 A Resolution requesting the House of Representatives to take such actions as may be necessary to enact certain legislation; and directing distribution. 10 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the First Extraordinary Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature convened on September 25, 2017, in order to consider the 14 agenda set forth by Governor Mary Fallin in Amended Executive Order 15 2017-29, including legislation necessary to address the immediate 16 budget shortfall created by the loss of \$215 million in cigarette 17 fee revenue for fiscal year 2018, to address a long-term solution to 18 continuing budget shortfalls and to address tax relief for low-19 20 income working Oklahomans; and WHEREAS, the Governor further called for consideration of 21 legislation to provide salary increases for Oklahoma teachers and 22 state employees; and 23

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 33 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution set forth requirements for enactment of revenue bills, one of which is that such measures must originate in the House of Representatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Senate hereby requests the honorable House of
Representatives to present to the Joint Committee on Appropriations
and Budget a measure originating in the House of Representatives
which includes the following provisions:

- 1. A new tax on cigarettes equal to \$1.50 per pack of twenty, as set forth in the Committee Substitute for House Bill 1035 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th Legislature;
- 2. A new tax on tobacco products, as set forth in the Committee Substitute for House Bill 1035 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th Legislature;
- 3. A new tax on gasoline and diesel fuel equal to \$0.06 per gallon, as set forth in the Committee Substitute for House Bill 1035 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th Legislature;
- 4. An increase in the tax on low-point beer to bring the tax rate to 13.5 percent, as set forth in the Committee Substitute for House Bill 1035 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th Legislature; and

5. An increase in the gross production tax on new oil and gas wells to four percent.

THAT the Senate further requests the honorable House of Representatives, following such action and upon a favorable report from the Joint Committee on Appropriations and Budget, to consider and pass such legislation on the House floor, with the three-fourths vote as required in Section 33 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution, and to take all other actions necessary to enact the provisions set forth herein, and pending legislation relating to salary increases for Oklahoma teachers and state employees, at the earliest possible time.
