Murrah Federal Building; 8 and directing distribution. 9 10 11 WHEREAS, at 9:02 a.m. on April 19, 1995, Oklahoma City was 12 struck by the worst act of domestic terrorism in U.S. history with 13 the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building; and 14 WHEREAS, 168 died, including 19 children. Additionally, three 15 of the women killed were pregnant. The dead also included three 16 state employees and one first responder. Hundreds more men, women, 17 and children were injured; and 18 WHEREAS, first responders from throughout Oklahoma and across 19 the country worked 24 hours a day in the search and rescue 20 operation. Oklahoma citizens quickly rallied to provide food, 21 water, and supplies to support first responders, and they donated 22 blood and made financial contributions to aid victims and their 23 families. The spirit of generosity and resilience witnessed by the

world became known as the Oklahoma Standard; and
