17	alliances: the Allies and the Axis; and
18	WHEREAS, on September 2, 1945, a formal surrender ceremony was
19	performed in Tokyo Bay, Japan, aboard the battleship USS Missouri;

21	WHEREAS, more than 405,000 Americans gave their lives during
22	World War II; and
23	WHEREAS, World War II was the deadliest military conflict in
24 2 -	history with an estimated 60-80 million casualties; and
