8	A Resolution recognizing May as Older Americans
9	Month; supporting and protecting the rights of nursing home residents; and directing distribution.

12	WHEREAS, a National Pandemic Health Emergency was announced on
13	March 13, 2020, and a state of emergency was announced in Oklahoma
14	on March 15, 2020, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
15	WHEREAS, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
16	were empowered to rapidly expand efforts to mitigate COVID-19; and
17	WHEREAS, Governor Stitt recommended on March 17, 2020, that
18	Oklahomans follow the president's coronavirus guidelines, including
19	guidance not to "visit nursing homes or retirement or long-term care
20	facilities unless to provide critical assistance." On March 27,
21	2020, visitors were prohibited from entering and visiting patients
22	and residents at these facilities; and
23	WHEREAS, the State Department of Health reported on January 1,
24	2021, that 760 Oklahoma nursing home residents had died from COVID-

1 19 while AARP reported that over 133,000 American nursing home 2 residents had died, representing 31% and 39% of all Oklahoma and 3 U.S. pandemic fatalities, respectively; and 4 WHEREAS, the U.S. Office of Inspector General reported in June 5 2021 that the mortality rate for Medicare beneficiaries in nursing 6 homes increased 32% in 2020, with 169,391 more deaths than 2019; and 7 WHEREAS, CMS expressed concern on April 7, 2022, about the 8 impact on residents' health and safety by the waived regulations, 9 and the length of time for which they had been waived; and 10 WHEREAS, no words or deeds can replace the loss of life or 11 adequately convey the depth of our sorrows, but we can work together 12 toward healing by recognizing all nursing home residents nationwide 13 for their sacrifices during the COVID-19 national emergency. 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION 15 OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 16 THAT the Oklahoma Senate hereby proclaims May 2023 as Older 17 Americans Month. 18 THAT the Oklahoma Senate will join efforts with aging and 19 resident advocacy organizations throughout the State of Oklahoma to 20 support and protect the rights of nursing home residents year-round. 21 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the 11 state 22 agencies on aging.
