17	WHEREAS, the number of U.S. Supreme Court justices has not
18	changed since 1869, making it a long-standing tradition and custom
19	of our great nation; and
20	WHEREAS, the President traditionally only appoints a justice in
21	the event of a seat becoming vacant; and
22	WHEREAS, there are currently only nine justices on the court,
23	six of whom were appointed by Republican presidents.
