20	WHEREAS, besides his standing committees, Senator Simpson's

3 WHEREAS, the 26-year retired U.S. Navy veteran has been a 4 tireless advocate for Oklahoma's military members, veterans, and 5 their families, with legislation designating Oklahoma as a Purple 6 Heart State; improving services and care in Oklahoma's veterans 7 centers; creating community-based homes for aging and terminally ill 8 veterans; and ensuring proper burial of veterans. He also 9 championed measures to streamline military student transfers; make 10 college more affordable for Oklahoma's heroes; promote equitable 11 access to state and federal benefits and services for female 12 veterans; protect National Guard members from employment 13 discrimination; and extend state benefits to peacetime veterans; and 14 WHEREAS, Senator Simpson also expanded the Trafficking in 15 Illegal Drugs Act; improved diabetes awareness and education 16 statewide as well as made insulin and other resources more 17 affordable; and protected the leave of state employees following 18 state emergencies; and

WHEREAS, while he had many accomplishments and made friendships that will last a lifetime, his greatest blessing was meeting his best friend, Karen, whom he married on May 22, 2021. Upon his retirement, they are looking forward to continuing their worldwide travels and spending more time with their beloved family; and
