7	A Resolution commemorating the 60th anniversary of the national motto; encouraging and supporting its

11	WHEREAS, the phrase "In God We Trust" was adopted as the
12	official motto of the United States in 1956 after it was approved
13	through a joint resolution by the 84th Congress and was signed by
14	President Eisenhower on July 30, 1956, and which is now codified in
15	36 U.S.C., Section 186; and
16	WHEREAS, the phrase was designed as an alternative to "E
17	pluribus unum", which was the first unofficial motto originally used
18	in 1782; and
19	WHEREAS, the phrase may have originated from the words of "The
20	Star-Spangled Banner" written during the war of 1812, as the fourth
21	stanza includes the phrase, "And this be our motto - In God is our
22	trust"; and
23	WHEREAS, the motto first appeared on U.S. coins in 1864 and on
24	paper currency in 1957; and

1 WHEREAS, from the crucible of the Civil War, Reverend M.R. Watkinson, in a letter dated November 13, 1861, petitioned the 2 3 Treasury Department to add a statement recognizing, "Almighty God in 4 some form on our coin". Treasury Secretary Salmon P. Chase acted on 5 Watkinson's proposal and instructed the Director of the Philadelphia Mint, James Pollock, to begin work on designs that coined the 6 7 phrase; and WHEREAS, legislation was introduced and passed on April 22, 8 9 1864, authorizing the inclusion of the phrase on one-cent and twocent coins. 10 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 12 13 THAT members of the Oklahoma State Senate commemorate the 60th anniversary of the adoption of the national motto, "In God We 14 Trust". 15 THAT members of the Oklahoma State Senate cultivate the public 16 display of the national motto. 17 18 55-2-3365 СС 4/19/2016 3:00:20 PM 19 20 21 22
