A Resolution encouraging the National Rifle Association to relocate their headquarters to Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, since territorial times, Oklahomans have been protective of the Second Amendment and their Constitutional right to bear arms; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature is committed to protecting citizens' Second Amendment rights, supporting and passing firearm friendly legislation including constitutional carry; and

WHEREAS, Oklahomans' love and appreciation of firearms is evident in that the state has the 9th highest firearms sales nationwide; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma is open for business, allowing business owners the right to make their own decisions on how to operate, open and close their own businesses; and

WHEREAS, founded in 1871, the National Rifle Association, the nation's oldest civil rights organization, finds itself looking to relocate; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma, that has proven to be a state working to protect an individuals' right to keep and bear arms, welcomes the

National Rifle Association and its mission to continue education and defense of civil rights in this state for centuries to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate encourages and welcomes the National Rifle Association to move their headquarters from Virginia to Oklahoma.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate also encourages any company that seeks freedom and liberty to locate and make its home in Oklahoma.
