11	WHEREAS, agriculture is one of Oklahoma's leading industries and
12	its associated production, processing, and marketing segments
13	together provide close to 200,000 jobs and contribute more than \$28
14	billion to our state's economy; and
15	WHEREAS, Oklahoma ranks fourth nationally with more than 77,200
16	farms and ranches, utilizing more than 34 million acres of
17	Oklahoma's rich land to provide food, fiber, and other basic
18	necessities of life to not only Oklahomans, but the nation and
19	world; and
20	WHEREAS, Oklahoma is known as the nation's premiere spot for
21	wheat production and research, ranking second for winter wheat
22	bushels harvested annually and third for the total bushels
23	harvested; and

1 WHEREAS, Oklahoma is also America's second leading provider of 2 beef cattle with more than two million head and has the third most 3 cattle operations at more than 52,000, featuring over five million 4 beef and milk cattle; and 5 WHEREAS, Oklahoma also ranks as the top provider of rye 6 nationally and is one of the highest producers of soybeans, cotton, 7 poultry, and pork in the U.S.; and 8 WHEREAS, agriculture provides a major source of employment for 9 Oklahoma's workforce with one in 50 jobs supported by the pork 10 industry and another 30,000 people employed by the poultry industry 11 as just two examples of the vast reach and importance of agriculture 12 in our state; and 13 WHEREAS, agriculture's success is vital to maintaining the 14 strength of Oklahoma's economy, the standard of living for our 15 citizens, and our presence in the world trade market; and 16 WHEREAS, it is important that all Oklahomans understand the role 17 that agriculture plays in their daily lives and well-being, whether 18 they live in urban or rural areas. 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION 20 OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 21 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate declares April 11, 2023, as 22 Oklahoma Agriculture Day at the Capitol. 23 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate recognizes and celebrates 24 agriculture's impact on our state's heritage and economy. _ _ Req.
