21	Texas, Colorado, and Oklahoma. She was also employed for nine years

23	invested a great deal of her efforts serving in various capacities

WHEREAS, Susan Paddack was a member of the first post-termlimits class of 2004 and has been a member of the Oklahoma State

Senate since that time, serving first in the majority, then in the evenly-divided Senate and eventually in the minority. Senator

Paddack serves as Co-chair for the Democratic Caucus and is a member on numerous other Senate committees. She has previously served as Chair of the Education Committee; and

WHEREAS, State Question 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for a member of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result, Senator Paddack will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Susan Paddack will most be remembered as a person of strength and compassion. These characteristics are reflected in her relentless pursuit of public service, whether as a volunteer, a classroom teacher or a Senator. Her attention to detail and demand for top effort from any individual involved was evident in the landmark legislation she authored for expanding prescription assistance and authorizing additional student health screenings. It was the passion for education and health care that fueled her strength to champion the policy for those that may be most vulnerable.
