PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4002

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Notwithstanding ORS 181A.820 and 181A.822 to
181A.829, when a person is arrested for delivery or manufacture of
fentanyl, the arresting officer shall immediately notify federal immigration authorities.

6 "(2) Notwithstanding ORS 135.230 to 135.290, a person arrested for 7 delivery or manufacture of fentanyl is not eligible for any form of re-8 lease, except as required by the Oregon Constitution, until the notifi-9 cation described in subsection (1) of this section has occurred and 10 federal immigration authorities have confirmed that the person does 11 not need to be detained for violating federal immigration law.

"(3) As used in this section, 'federal immigration authorities' means
agents of the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement,
or a successor agency, who receive reports of and investigate violations of immigration law.".
